

CASE STUDY

A COMPLEX JOURNEY TO SUSTAINABLE LUXURY

Nestled on Bahrain's pristine Hawar Island. Hawar Resort by Mantis blends adventure. comfort, and sustainability. As a pioneering environmentally focused destination in the Middle East, the resort is surrounded by a thriving wildlife sanctuary. It features 102 elegant accommodations, including overwater villas, 5 dining venues, a spa, and extensive sports facilities, Kids Club and Adventure Park, Waterpark and many offerings for outdoor activities such as Paddle boarding, Kayaking, Snorkeling Bird watching, Safari under the stars and Cooking classes, all that required specialized sourcing. The property also boasts a Recycling, Water & Energy Conservation Program.

The Mantis Hawar project exemplifies how careful management and practical solutions can transform challenges into opportunities, resulting in a luxury eco-tourism destination that celebrates both the natural beauty and cultural heritage of Bahrain. Despite the complexities of working in a remote location, the project was brought to completion on time and within budget through meticulous planning, strategic value engineering, and agile problem-solving.

Coordinating the transportation of items to Hawar Island, a remote location, posed significant logistical challenges. Items had to be consolidated in Manama before being taken to the island by barge, requiring precise planning to catch available barges to ensure timely delivery and installation.

The ongoing situation in the Red Sea caused unexpected disruptions in supply routes, which could have delayed the project. However, our team's agile approach ensured swift adjustments to the plan, minimizing disruptions and preserving the overall timeline. The ability to quickly adapt to changing circumstances is a key to maintaining project momentum.

Tight budget limitations required an extensive value engineering, balancing cost with quality and sustainability goals. This involved making selective adjustments to materials while preserving the integrity of the original design. Close collaboration with vendors was essential to meet the project's high standards and ensure that all items were delivered on time. As always, we focused on building strong relationships with suppliers, enabling us to negotiate the best outcomes for the project.

HOW WE MANAGED TO PRODUCE, DELIVER AND INSTALL A FULLY BESPOKE ULTRA LUXURY VILLA IN **MAURITIUS UNDER 3 MONTHS**

Crafted for a discerning clientele, the Private Homes at One&Only Le Saint Geran demand meticulous design coordination.

Every piece of equipment was custom-tailored, with the highest craftsmanship quality.

Delivering a Show Villa within a mere 3 months posed a formidable challenge, given the precise production requirements, transportation logistics, and intricate importing regulations in Mauritius—all while adhering to budget constraints.

Balancing the requirements of a large scale tender in anticipation of a 52 villas roll out, while procuring only 1 piece of each item for the Sales Show Villa, required strategic foresight and a very close collaboration with suppliers.


To achieve complete client satisfaction, we allocated additional resources beyond typical project scope. Our designers created or supervised all custom productions. while a specialist coordinated logistics to keep a high processing pace.

Very close vendors' management was required to ensure timely and impeccable execution of all orders.

CASE STUDY

HOW WE MANAGED TO SOURCE, EXPORT AND IMPORT OVER 200 ANTIQUE AND VINTAGE PIECES FROM WEST EUROPE TO GEORGIA FOR AN HISTORICAL AND HERITAGE PROJECT

Tsinandali Estate, birthplace of Georgian wine-making, holds a rich history within Kakheti's wine region, once owned by the Chavchavadze family, notably Prince Alexander Chavchavadze (1786-1846), a revered poet and leader.

The Radisson Collection Tsinandali presented a distinctive challenge: to uphold operational standards and international luxury hospitality requirements while honouring the estate's rich history.


The preservation of the heritage building necessitated careful selection of materials, overseen by government officials and restoration experts. Additionally, the fit-out of public areas was guided solely by the artistic direction of renowned lighting designer Ingo Maurer and Georgian artist Tamara Kzesitadze. Managing the intricate design required a specialized team. Our Design and FF&E specialists developed a comprehensive specification book based on the visions of the two Art Directors.

To maintain authenticity within budget constraints, we scoured antique markets and auction houses for furniture, lighting fixtures, rugs and accessories, and hand-picked unique pieces, negotiating prices piece by piece with antiquarians and private owners.

Orders management, financial tracking, and export logistics prove extraordinarily complex thanks to vendors' preference for cash payments without receipts and reluctance to provide necessary documents for international transport.

The hotel opened in 2018 and immediately garnered acclaim, including being named a finalist for the "Best Hotel & Tourism Resort Award" at MIPIM2020, thanks to its hand-crafted interiors, premium lifestyle facilities, and unwavering character and authenticity.




